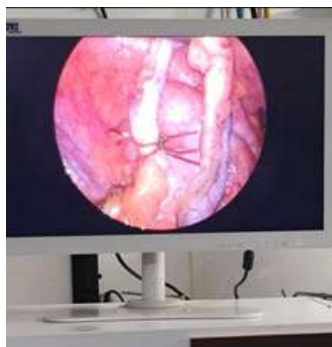

Appendicectomy

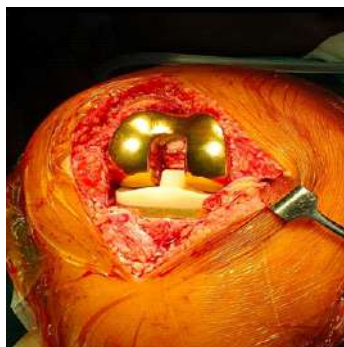
A 14-year-old male patient, Master Mohammed Abbas, was admitted with complaints of abdominal pain in the periumbilical region for one week along with high-grade fever for five days. After detailed clinical evaluation, he was diagnosed with Acute Appendicitis and was advised to undergo Laparoscopic Appendicectomy. The procedure was successfully performed under expert medical supervision. Following surgery, the patient showed good recovery with improved oral intake and significant reduction in pain. He was discharged in stable condition with advice on diet management and regular follow-up care.

Mrs. Amena Ayesha, a 58-year-old female patient, was admitted with complaints of chronic bilateral knee pain for the past two to three years. After thorough evaluation, she was diagnosed with Bilateral Severe Osteoarthritis Grade IV and was advised to undergo Total Knee Replacement surgery. The procedure was successfully performed under expert supervision, followed by comprehensive post-operative care including pain management, antibiotics, and physiotherapy. The patient responded well to treatment with improved mobility and reduced pain, and her rehabilitation progress was found to be satisfactory. She was discharged in stable condition with advice for regular follow-up and continued physiotherapy.
