ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS






Mr. Sarat Yenigalla

FROM THE CEO'S DESK

2025 has been a year of deepened impact, renewed purpose, and continued service to the ones that rely on us the most. As we reflect on our journey, we are reminded once again that meaningful change is driven not by resources alone, but by compassion, collaboration, and the unwavering belief that every life deserves dignity, opportunity, and hope.

This year, our work expanded across education, healthcare, social welfare, and community development in ways that strengthened our commitment to inclusive growth. The progress we have made, together with our partners, donors, and volunteers, has paved the way for sustainable transformation across some of the most underserved regions.

In education, we supported more than 13 institutions and enabled over 900 students to continue their learning through scholarships in coordination with AMES. More than 3,000 young people gained employable skills through our training centres, while 60 students received paramedical education at the Indo-US Healthcare Academy. With a combined student strength of over 7,200 across all supported institutions, we remain steadfast in our mission to bridge educational disparities and equip youth for a brighter future.

In healthcare, we expanded access to essential medical services for communities that often face the greatest barriers. Over 11,000 free dialysis sessions were provided to patients with chronic kidney diseases with the support of Bhagwan Mahavir Jain Relief Foundation Trust. We conducted 1,300+ cataract surgeries and screened more than 3,500 individuals for early eye-related issues. Our free clinics treated more than 37,000 patients, offering both outpatient and inpatient care to those who would otherwise remain unseen by the healthcare system.

In social welfare, we intensified our outreach to support vulnerable families, senior citizens, women, and children. More than 3,000 individuals were guided through our counselling centre at Talab Katta. Our daily cooked-meal programme in Hyderabad served nearly 300,000 meals across two locations, ensuring food security for hundreds each day. We continued supporting widows, elderly residents in old-age homes, and girls at the Challenger Home Orphanage. Our ambulance services in Nandyal, Andhra Pradesh, remained completely free, providing dignity and relief in moments of emergency and loss. We also strengthened essential infrastructure by installing four borewells in Odisha, ensuring reliable access to clean water for multiple villages.

Our achievements this year were made possible through the support of valued partners. Our collaboration with the Bhagwan Mahavir Jain Relief Foundation Trust strengthened our dialysis services. Together with the Pushpagiri Vitreo Retina Institute and Indo-US Eye Hospital, we continued restoring sight through free cataract surgeries. Our CSR partnership with Tech Mahindra advances community empowerment through teachers' training. Through Code for India, we continued building digital literacy, while Full Stack Academy enhanced technical training opportunities. Our collaboration with Edventure Park further expanded innovation and entrepreneurship by offering a hardware and business incubation platform to students from diverse backgrounds.

Each milestone we achieved in 2025 is a testament to what we can accomplish when compassion is matched with commitment. As we look ahead, our focus remains on expanding impact, strengthening partnerships, and ensuring that every individual—regardless of background—has access to the education, healthcare, and support they deserve.




OUR INITIATIVES

EDUCATION

At Sahayata Trust, we believe that education is the cornerstone of individual advancement and social progress. This year, we strengthened our commitment by investing in a range of educational initiatives across our schools, colleges, and skill development centres, each of which is designed to equip students with the knowledge and skills they need to succeed in today's world.

- Supported 13+ educational institutions across various regions, strengthening access to quality education.
- Provided scholarships to over 900 students, in collaboration with AMES, enabling those facing financial hardships to continue their studies.
- Trained 3,000+ students through skill development centres, including the Afzal Sagar Skill Centre in Hyderabad, offering courses such as mobile repairing and stitching.
- Facilitated paramedical training for 60+ students at the Indo-US Healthcare Academy in Malakpet, Hyderabad, opening pathways to healthcare careers.
- Achieved a combined student strength of more than 7,200 across our educational institutions for the year

HEALTHCARE




Many people in India avoid visiting hospitals simply because they cannot afford hospital expenses. Rising healthcare costs makes it difficult for economically vulnerable families to access essential medical services, often resulting in untreated illnesses and long-term health challenges. To address this gap and ensure that quality healthcare reaches those who need it most, Sahayata Trust has launched a range of healthcare programmes and community-focused initiatives.



HEALTHCARE MILESTONES IN 2025

- Provided 11,000+ free dialysis sessions, ensuring critical support for patients with chronic kidney conditions.
- Conducted 1,300+ cataract surgeries, restoring vision and improving quality of life for underserved individuals.
- Delivered healthcare services to 37,000+ patients through Sahayata Trust hospitals, including 35,000 outpatient and 2,000 inpatient treatments.
- Screened 3,500+ individuals for eye-related issues, enabling early detection and timely medical intervention.
- Screened 4,000+ individuals in Telangana and Gujarat through the "India Health Initiative" programme. The programme provided free medicines and diagnostic tests to support timely treatment and better health outcomes.

SOCIAL WELFARE





Sahayata Trust continues to uplift vulnerable communities through a wide range of social welfare programmes that focus on education support, food security, elderly care, orphan support, healthcare access, and essential community infrastructure. These initiatives aim to address immediate needs while ensuring long-term dignity, stability, and better living conditions for underserved families across multiple states.



SOCIAL WELFARE MILESTONES IN 2025

- Guided 3,000+ individuals through our counselling centre in Talab Katta, offering assistance related to education, employment, health, and family matters.
- Food & Basic Needs Support
- 100+ widows supported with daily feeding, receiving monthly ration supplies.
- Daily cooked meal programme serving 800+ people, provided across Eraggadda and Balanagar, reaching nearly 300,000 beneficiaries this year.
- 50+ families receive free monthly life-saving medicines and essential supplies.



Elderly Care

- 40+ senior citizens supported at Habeeb Old Age Home, Shastripuram.
- 20+ senior citizens supported at Nesh Elder Seva Home for Old Age in Samrat Nagar, Neral, Maharashtra.

Child Care & Protection

- Continued support to Challenger Home Orphanage for Girls, ensuring safe shelter, nutrition, education, and emotional care.



Health Access & Emergency Support

- Free ambulance services provided in Nandyal, Andhra Pradesh, assisting patients who require hospital transportation, and offering free transport of deceased individuals to graveyards and cremation grounds. These services remain completely free for all.
- Water & Infrastructure Support
- Four borewells installed in Jajpur District, Odisha, providing reliable access to clean water in the following locations:
 - Panikolli
 - Lalkhan Mohalla (Korai)
 - Gopalpur Katla
 - Pathan Mohalla (Purshottampur)

These installations help ensure safe and dependable water supply for the villages.
